Breastplate of Righteousness

What you will need:


- Two sheets with lines per breastplate, printed on construction paper (card). A copy of the 'Righteousness' strip printed on card.
- Two blank sheets of construction paper (card) per breastplate.
- Scissors
- A punch
- Tin foil (Aluminum foil)
- String
- Craft glue (white glue), glue stick.
- Plastic cup or similar sized round object.


Construction

• Follow the instructions on pages 2 and 3.



Glue two blank sheets together along the length of the sheet using a glue stick.






Glue the two zig-zag strips onto the back of the breastplate, as shown below.

Front


Spread craft glue around the edge of the breastplate and lay it glue-side down on a sheet of tin foil. Trim off, or fold over, the overlapping parts of foil.


Glue the 'Righteousness' strip on the front RIGHTEOUSNESS




Punch a hole in the top corners to tie on a string that loops around the child's neck.
