Luke 22:14-16

Jesus dies - the whole land becomes dark. The curtain in the temple is torn from top to bottom.  
Luke 23:44-46

Jesus forgives the thief hanging on a cross next to him.  
Luke 23:40-43

Peter denies Jesus. He says that he doesn't even know who Jesus is.  
Matthew 26:58, 69-75

Jesus is taken to Pilate the governor. Pilate finds no fault with Jesus but has him flogged.  
Mark 15:1-15

Jesus and the disciples go a garden called Gethsemane. He prays to His Father in Heaven.  
Mark 14:32-36

Bad people come and arrest Jesus. They take Him to the house of Caiaphas, the high priest.  
Matthew 26:55-57, 59-60

Jesus is buried by his friends. Joseph and Nicodemus put the body of Jesus in a tomb.  
John 19:38-42

They lead Jesus away and nail Him to a cross.
