The slider helps children focus on one aspect at the time.

Things you will need:

Per child : A copy of the plaque printed on construction paper (card) - page 3
The slider printed on construction paper (three per page) - page 4
A paper fastener (split pin).

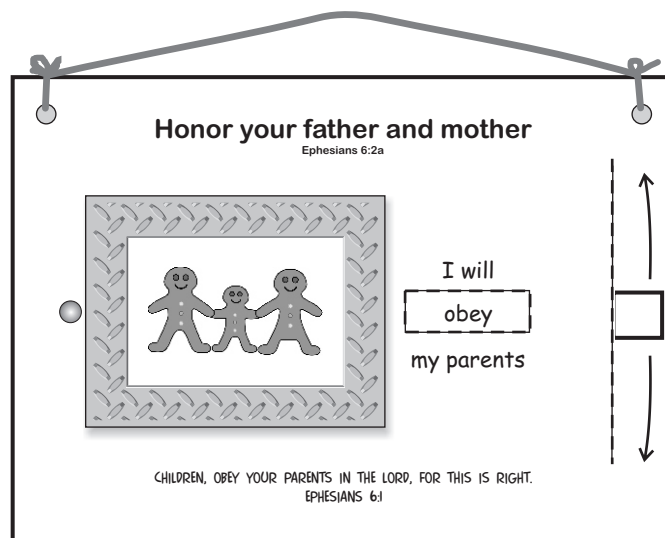
Per group : Scissors

A nail (or something sharp) to make a hole in the card.

Paper glue.

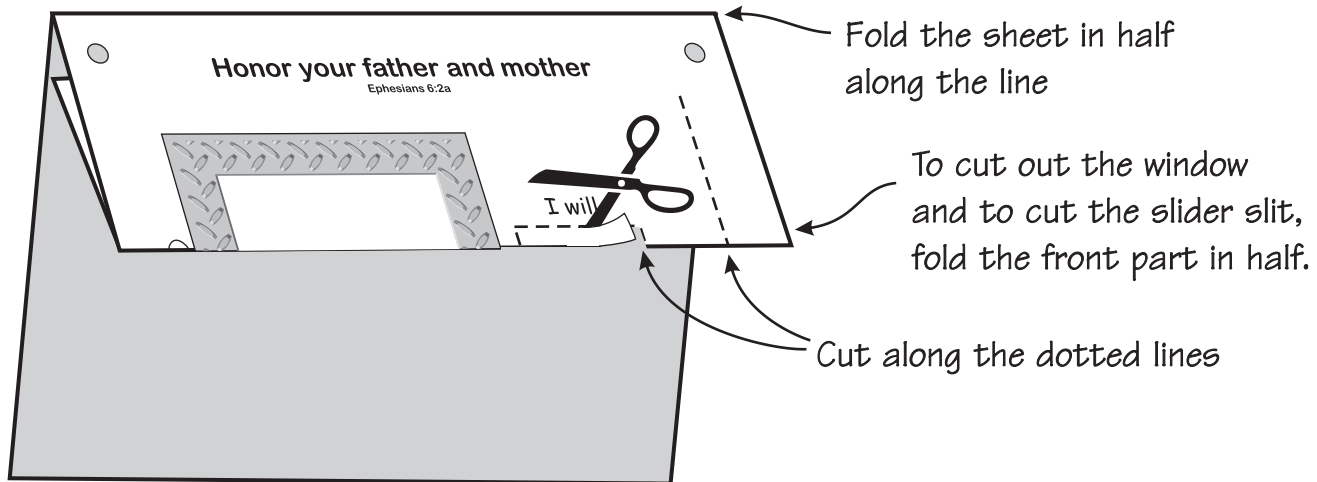
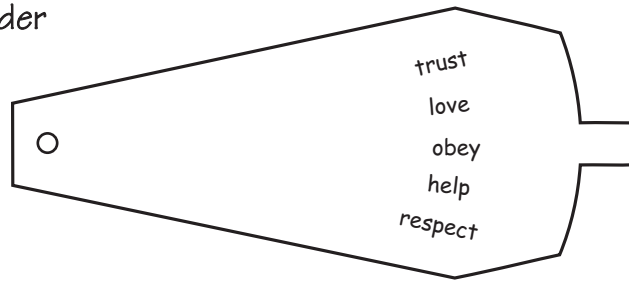
Construction

- Decorate the picture.



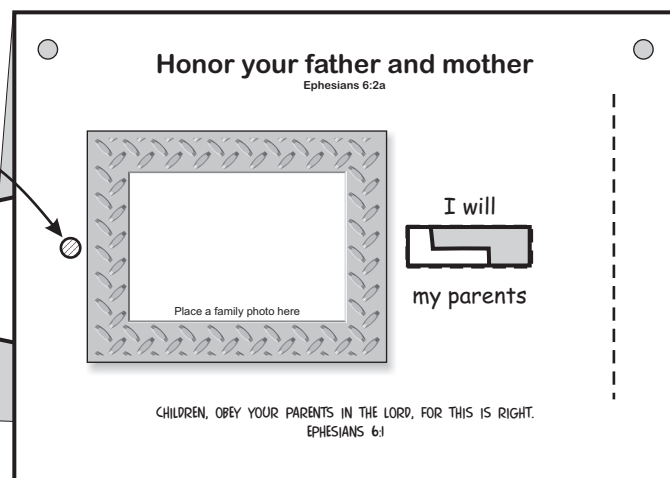
Cut out the selection slider

Page 2

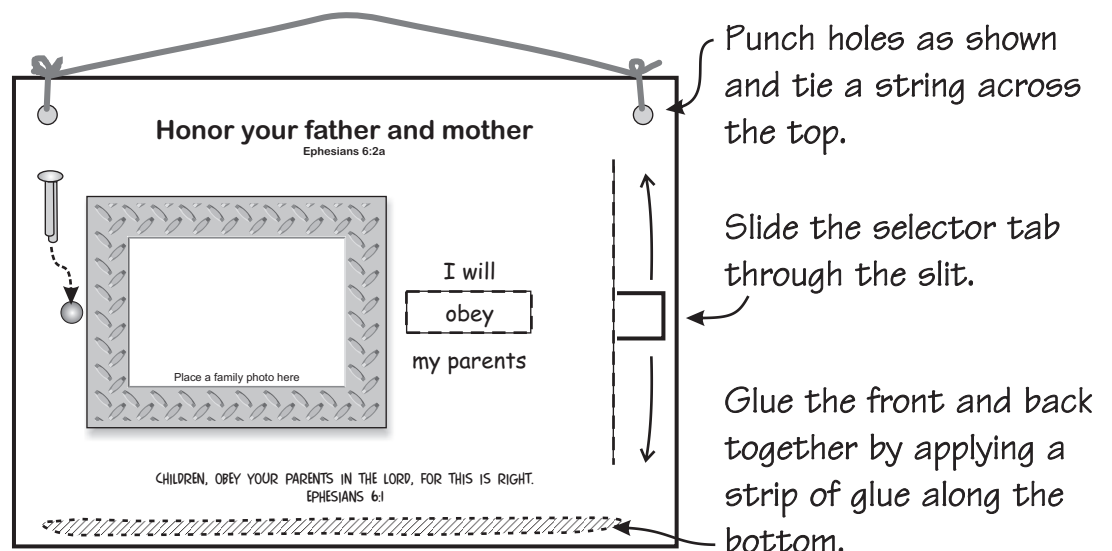


Punch a hole in the front and in the slider.

Place the slider behind the front section and line up the holes.



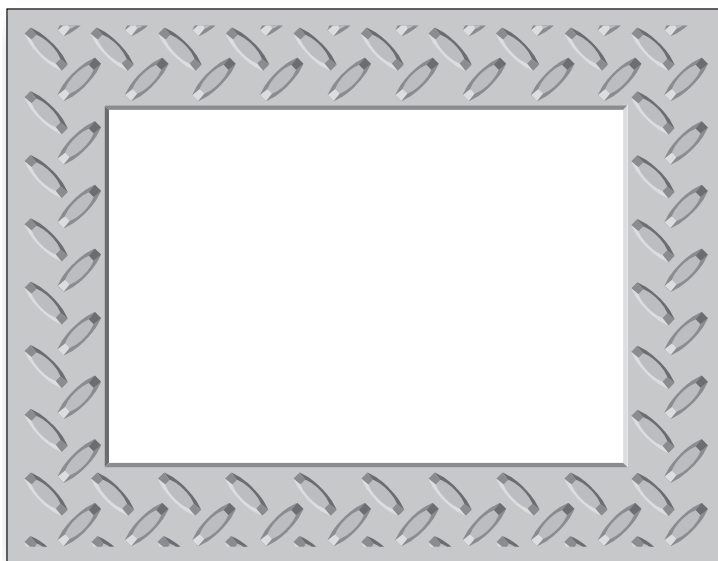
Secure the slider with a paper fastener.



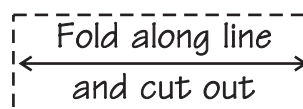
Fold along line
